A Presentation of the “Feasts of Israel” Presentation at Our Home

We began the 2 ½ hour presentation with our most recent presentation at 4:00 and concluded with a 10-minute break at 6:30. It’s an intimate setting, and I use **many** Jewish “articles” and “props” placed on the island to help reveal the pictures of each Feast. We can schedule another presentation if more than 12 of your folks want to come for this one.

I believed in the Gospel of Jesus Christ when I was 19 at “Marsh Lane Baptist Church” in Dallas, TX, our first church home for 12 years. I played the trumpet in the orchestra, where I met Michelle, who plays the cello. By age 30, I was teaching a Sunday School Class (book of Hebrews, verse by verse). We were members at “Bent Tree Bible Fellowship” in Carrollton, Texas, our second home church, for over 30 years. Michelle and I moved to Trussville in Dec. 2023 after she retired from being on church staff for 24 years. I founded the non-profit ministry “Good Mood Foundation” in 2005. Ministry is a labor of love, so since beginning “our” ministry, I have **not** received any salary, income, royalty, or financial benefit. Instead, I have invested my time and personal resources to *help* fund “our” ministries. Therefore, conducting the “Feasts of Israel” is one of the many ways I serve the Gentiles.

Overview of the Feasts of Israel

In Leviticus 25, God commands His people to observe “Seven Feasts.” They are;

1. **Passover**
2. **Unleavened Bread**
3. **First Fruits**
4. **Pentecost**
5. **Trumpets**
6. **Day of Atonement**
7. **Tabernacles**

Like any study in the Old Testament, the “Feasts of Israel” is analogous to a “Connecting the Dots” workbook. So, we’ll connect the dots to reveal the “pictures” found in each Feast. We’ll begin with Passover, which *incorporates* the first three feasts and is a celebration of the:

- “**Last (Passover) Supper**”
- “**Resurrection of Jesus Christ**”
- “**New Covenant**”

We’ll present the Passover “Seder”— the precursor to “**Communion**,” in which we will partake. After understanding the Passover, Communion at church moving forward will never be the same. Then, we’ll examine each of God’s Eight Covenants. Understanding the details of the “Old Covenant” is vital to understanding why God said He would replace it with the “New”



Covenant.” *“The time is coming,” declares the LORD, “when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. It will not be like the Covenant I made with their forefathers when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt because they broke my Covenant... This is the Covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time,” declares the LORD. “I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people...I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.”* Jer. 31:31-34.

Beginning with Passover, Jesus Fulfilled the **First Four Feasts** Perfectly—the elements of the **Gospel**.

1. Jesus Christ **was crucified on the cross as a sin substitute**, and His blood was spilled to cover and forgive **all** past, present, and future sins. It occurred on **Passover**.
2. Jesus **died and was buried** that same day on **Unleavened Bread**.
3. Three days later, the gravestone that sealed Jesus’ body was miraculously rolled away, and **Jesus Christ was resurrected**. It occurred on **First Fruits**.
4. Jesus Christ **gives us His LIFE** through the indwelling Holy Spirit. It occurred on **Pentecost**.

We are living in the **Church Age**, a transitory period that **will end** after the **last Shofar Trumpet** is “sounded,” and believers gathered (raptured) to be with Jesus, fulfilling the **Feast of Trumpets**. *“Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last Trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.”* 1 Cor. 15:51-55

During the presentation, I will teach everyone how to sound the “Shofar Trumpet” and present a “Shofar” to each “family” as a gift to take home and continue sounding. Pictured, I am in Tel Aviv, Israel, two minutes after “sunset” on April 25, 2023, sounding my Shofar Trumpet to announce the **start** of Israel’s **75th Anniversary**. **A highlight of my life!** Click **“Sounded”** on our website to see this video. The next Feast, the **Day of Atonement**, is the **day** each year that the Jewish **High Priest** entered the **Holy of Holies** (in the Tabernacle, First, and Second Temple) to make intercession with God for Israel’s sins. The Romans destroyed the Second Temple in 70 A.D., so the Jews have NOT been able to observe this Feast **Biblically** for 2,000 years. The Jews want a **Third Temple**, but they can’t build it because the Muslim shrine “Dome of the Rock” sits on the **Temple Mount**.

What to do?

We must understand the Book of Daniel to understand what the Bible says about rebuilding the Third Temple. Chapter 9 contains the **most significant prophecy in the Bible**. As this prophecy also indicates, when the Jewish Messiah **arrives** and **dies**, we must understand it **to share it with our Jewish friends**.

The background is that King Nebuchadnezzar led Israel into captivity in Babylon for 70 years, fulfilling Jeremiah’s prophecy. Two or three years before this “70” years is complete, God’s Angel “Gabriel” appears in Scripture for the first time, and he gives Daniel a prophecy of **“70 7’s” or 490 years**, revealing **God’s plans for Israel, Jerusalem, the Jewish people, the coming Jewish Messiah, and the rebuilding of the Third Jewish Temple**.

God is NOT a Liar

If this prophecy is **not** true, then God is a liar, and if God is a liar, then by definition, he is not God. Scripture is either **ALL** true or it’s not! Following is the passage in **BLACK**. I’ve added commentary to help you to understand.

“Seventy ‘Sevens’ [70 x 7 = 490 years] are decreed for your people [Israel and the Jews] and your Holy City [Jerusalem]...From the issuing of the decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the Anointed One, the ruler, [Messiah] comes, [His Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem riding on a donkey] there will be seven ‘sevens’ [7 x 7 = 49 years] and sixty-two ‘sevens’ [62 x 7 = 434 years] [Therefore, the Jewish Messiah will arrive 49 years plus 434 years for a total of 483 years after the issuing of the “decree”] After the sixty-two ‘sevens,’ the Anointed One will be cut off [Messiah will die] ... The people of the ruler [Romans] who will come will destroy the city [Jerusalem] and the [Second Temple] sanctuary. [The “period” represents a “Time Gap” that begins. The “math” and historical accounts verify the exact dates all the above prophecies were fulfilled, but they only account for 483 years. Where are the missing seven years? They are revealed in the Book of Revelation and called the “Tribulation,” which begins after the church is “raptured” and the “Time Gap” is over] [Then “He,” a world leader, most likely the Antichrist, will arrive on the scene] He will confirm a covenant with many [Israel and other Nations] for “one seven.” [7 years] [The covenant must also move the “Dome of the Rock” off the Temple Mount so that the “Third Temple” can be built there] In the middle of the seven [3 ½ years into the covenant], he will end sacrifice and offering [“he” ends the sacrificial system in the Jewish Third Temple], And on a wing [Most likely the Holy Place] of the Temple, he will set up an abomination that causes desolation [Jesus refers to this abomination that causes desolation in Matt 24] until the end that is decreed is poured out on him.” [Satan is cast into the Lake of Fire]

See **“Workbook”** for the math, which verifies all the prophecies before the “Time Gap” is fulfilled.

- ❖ King Artaxerxes became King in **464 BC**, and 20 years later, on **March 5, 444 BC**, he issued a **“decree”** to rebuild Jerusalem and the First Temple. Now count “7 7’s,” or 49 years after this decree was issued, and in **396 BC**, Jerusalem and the First Temple were rebuilt.
- ❖ Now count “7 7’s” and “62 7’s for a total of “69 7’s” or 483 after this “decree” is issued, which is when the Jewish Messiah, **“Anointed One,”** arrives on **Monday, March 30, 33 A.D.**
- ❖ The Messiah was “cut off” (died by crucifixion) on **Passover, Friday, April 3, 33 A.D.**
- ❖ In **70 A.D.**, “the people of the ruler” (Romans) came and destroyed the city (Jerusalem) and the sanctuary (Second Temple). The “Time Gap” begins.

The “Time Gap” concludes at the “rapture,” as the “Tribulation” begins. The Book of Revelation indicates that when Jesus returns, **“Every eye will see Him. Even those who pierced Him,”** [referring to the Jews] **and all the people of the earth will mourn because of him.** Therefore when the Jewish People “see” Jesus, they will mourn, weep, and finally acknowledge that HE is their Jewish Messiah. Hallelujah, God’s redemptive plan for Israel is finally realized as ALL of Israel will be “Saved” — what a glorious “Day of Atonement” it will be, fulfilling the sixth Feast **Day of Atonement.**

God will create a **“New Heaven,”** and the Church will return to a **“New Earth”** in new glorified bodies and will rule and reign with Jesus for 1,000 years in the **“New Jerusalem.”** We will “dwell” or live in rooms called “Tabernacles,” fulfilling the seventh Feast of **Tabernacles.**

The Jews added two more Feasts. The Book of Esther is the story of the Feast of **Purim.** Jews gather to read the entire book of Esther out loud. Whenever the name **Haman** (the Jew-hater who wanted to kill all the Jews) is mentioned, the Jews use “noisemakers” to drown out his name. **Hanukkah** (called the “Feast of Dedication” mentioned in John) celebrates how Judas the Maccabee came to the desecrated Temple and “restored” it for its original intention. When he relit the Temple “Lampstand,” there was only one day’s supply of “Specially Pressed” olive oil. But he reignited the “Lampstand” anyway, and God miraculously kept the Menorah lit for eight days until a new supply of “special oil” could be produced. Jews progressively light an eight-candle Menorah for eight nights using the “Shamas” candle to light them. Jesus is the “Shamas.” He is the “Light” of the World.
